Pratt & Whitney Diverts Waste and Invests in the Local Community through Green Standards Ltd.

Driven by aggressive sustainability targets at Pratt & Whitney, particularly Zero Waste by 2025, Scott Hendershot, Project Manager - Sustainable Development, and his team diverted 285 workstations, desks and chairs from an office renovation at their Mississauga facility.

Through their participation in the Materials Exchange Program, they were introduced to and partnered with Green Standards Ltd. to distribute their furniture to 14 local non-profits, including the Harbourfront Centre, The Dwelling, and Children's Peace Theatre, among others. The donated items have a fair market value of \$57,925, and are all being reused, benefiting worthwhile charities, which extends their useful lifespan, prevents material from entering the waste stream, and decreases demand for new products.
